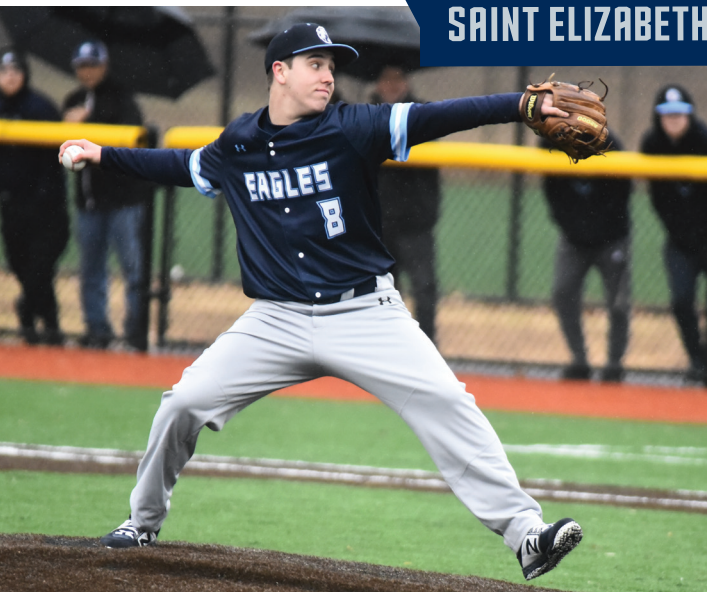


Saint Elizabeth is home to 12 NCAA Division III women's and men's sports teams.

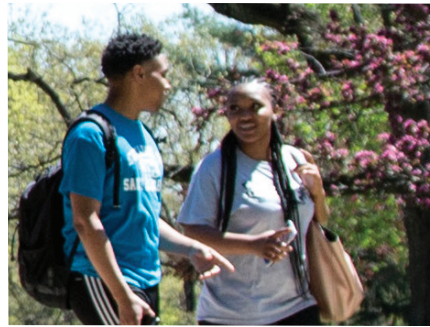
**Located in Morristown, New Jersey, SEU is in a beautiful suburban setting.**

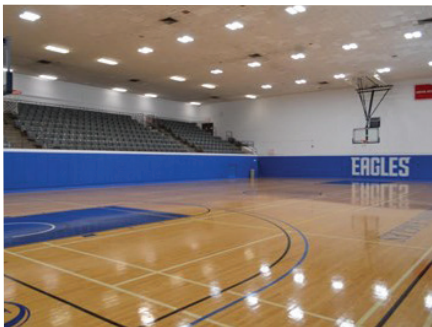

## FINANCIAL AID

Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Go to [fafsa.gov](http://fafsa.gov) for the application.

- File your FAFSA annually between October 1 and April 15 to maximize access to available financial assistance. After April 15, aid will be awarded based on remaining funding levels.
- Indicate Saint Elizabeth University as the school to receive your information. Our Federal School Code is 002600.
- Approximately three to five days after you submit the FAFSA online, you will receive an email allowing you to view your Student Aid Report (SAR) online. Saint Elizabeth University will receive your information from the federal government.

Typically, financial aid offer details are released to those with a valid FAFSA on file beginning in December. You will receive a college financing plan that explains the federal, state and/or University aid for which you qualify.

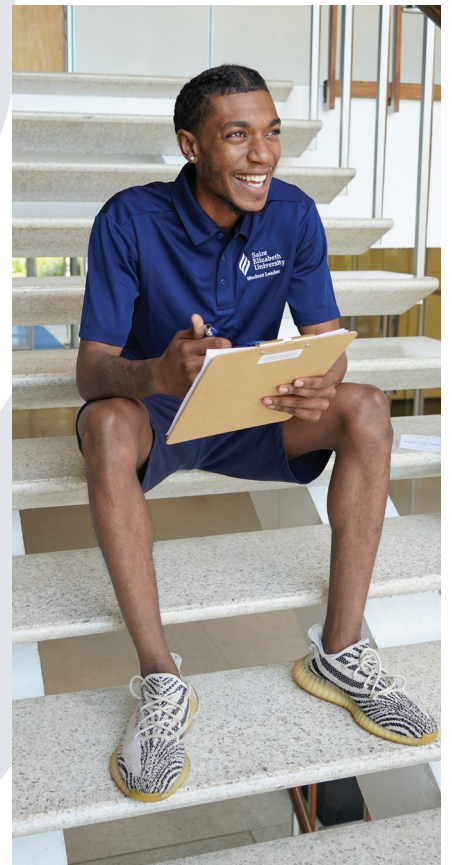

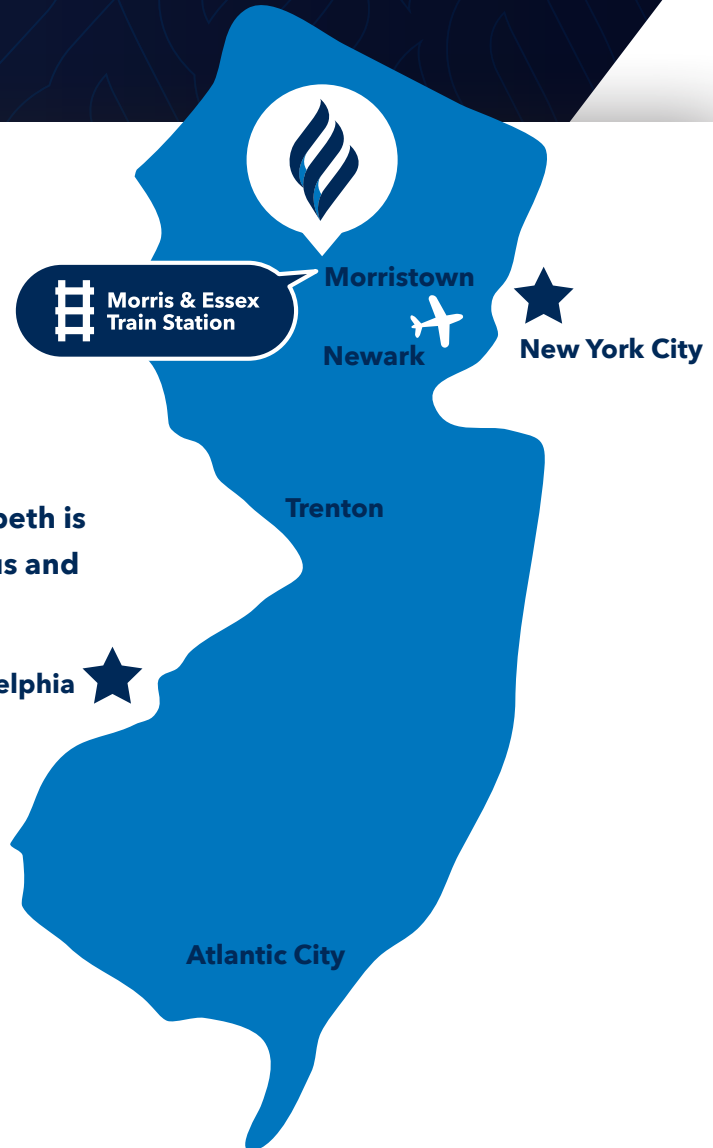
